

Information pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of Regulation EU/679/16

Pursuant to Article 13 of the Regulation EU/679/16 about the treatment of personal data concerning the protection of personal data, Neutron S.p.a. with registered office in Stradello Aggazzotti, n. 104 - 41126 - MODENA - VAT number IT03807840362 as DATA CONTROLLER, informs that the personal data acquired with reference to established business relationships will be processed in compliance with the aforementioned law; in relation to the aforementioned treatments it also provides the following information.

DATA PROTECTION OFFICER (DPO)

PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data collected are essentially related to:

- identification data (reason or company name, tel. office, fax, e-mail, fiscal data, etc.);
- data relating to economic and commercial activity (orders, solvency, banking and financial data, accounting and tax data, etc.);
- data relating to corporate managers of customers and suppliers and their corporate role.

This data is provided by you directly or can be collected:

- by independent third party data controllers (for example in our network of agents and representatives, during the creation and compilation of the relative contracts and / or orders);
- or through public information companies or registers, lists or public databases (for example data relating to financial solvency, or companies and agencies specialized in market research and statistics).

LEGAL BASIS OF THE TREATMENT

The legal bases that legitimize the treatment are:

1. the execution of the contract of which the data subject himself is a part (art. 6, par. 1, lett. B. Reg. EU/2016/679);
2. the execution of legal obligations (pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, lett. C. Reg. EU/2016/679);
3. the consent provided by the person concerned by means of a special flag affixed to the site, on the occasion of a request for assistance (pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter a. Of Reg. EU/2016/679).

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

The purposes of the processing of personal data are as follows:

1. execution of the contracts stipulated with you and the related commitments with the exclusion of the statistical processing of all the data on the consumption of food you have entered;
2. fulfillment of the legal obligations connected to the contractual relationship;
3. organizational management of the contract;
4. any external professional collaborations for the fulfillment of legal obligations;
5. protection of contractual rights;
6. internal statistical analysis such as the creation of statistical reports requested by customers;
7. marketing activities by sending promotional and advertising material concerning products or services similar to those covered by the existing commercial relationship;
8. general accounting and solvency information;
9. substitutive conservation of the computer and analogical documents relevant for tax purposes (Legislative Decree March 7, 2005, n. 82; Decree of the Minister of Economy and Finance January 23, 2004; Circular 06-12-2006 n.36, Revenue Agency; Resolution Number 11/2004 of 19 February 2004).
10. substitutive conservation of IT documents in general.

NATURE OF THE PROVISION OF DATA

The provision of the data and the relative processing are obligatory in relation to the purposes n. 1, 2, 5 relating to the contractual and legal obligations; the provision is also to be considered mandatory in relation to purposes 3 and 4 which refer to the performance of all the activities of the undersigned necessary and functional to the execution of the obligations contractual and legal; it follows that any refusal to provide the data for these purposes may determine the impossibility of the writer to carry out the contractual relationships and legal obligations.

The provision of data and the relative treatment is to be considered optional in other situations.

MODALITY OF TREATMENT

Personal data will be processed on paper, computerized, electronically and included in the relevant databases (customers, suppliers, administration, correspondence, production management, quality management systems, preventive management, controlled access e-commerce) which they will be able to access and, then, to get to know, the sales people, production, administration, quality system, supply offices expressly designated by the undersigned as being in charge of the processing of personal data and who can carry out operations of consultation, use, processing, comparison and any other appropriate operation also automated in compliance with the provisions of the law to guarantee, among other things, the confidentiality and security of data as well as the accuracy, updating and relevance of the data with respect to the declared purposes.

DATA STORAGE TIME

Information pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of Regulation EU/679/16

The personal data and all the data relating to the test results as well as the relative traces, worksheets, raw data, images will be processed by the Data Controller limited to what is necessary for the pursuit of the purposes referred to in this statement. In particular, personal data will be stored for a period of time equal to five years (former code of ethics for the practice of the profession of chemist App. I point 4), subject to a further retention period which may be imposed by rules of law, as also provided by recital 65 of Regulation EU/2016/679.

SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION AND DIFFUSION OF DATA

In relation to the purposes indicated in points 1, 2 and 5 the data may be communicated to the following subjects or to the categories of subjects indicated below:

- Transport companies and freight forwarders for aspects related to the shipment of goods and customs procedures;
- Banking institutions for the management of receipts and payments;
- Financial administrations and other companies or public bodies in compliance with regulatory obligations;
- Companies and law firms for the protection of contractual rights;
- Consultants and freelancers, even in associated form.

For the purposes n. 3 and 4 the data may be communicated to agents, representatives, brokers who work for the writer, contractor companies, self-employed workers and client companies.

For the purpose n. 6 the communication of data is not envisaged except for the disclosure of statistics in aggregate and anonymous form.

For the purpose n. 7 the communication of data to the outside is generally not provided, except for the communication to agents or representatives of the undersigned who will take care of the presentation or sending of the material in situations already authorized by the customer with the expression of consent.

For the purpose n. 8 all accounting documents in addition to the financial analysis on solvency are entrusted to companies appointed by us.

For the purpose n. 9 we inform you that we use companies that provide the replacement storage service, according to the laws in force, and of which we have specific guarantees.

For the purpose n. 10 The original Test Reports with Digital Signature may be transmitted using Certified E-Mail (PEC), which company performing the conservation has been entrusted by us.

All the companies for the treatment and storage services described above, have been appointed as Data Processors for their respective duties. Personal data will not be disclosed. The updated list of external appointees can be requested by the secretariat by e-mail address: info@neutron.it.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

In relation to the aforementioned treatments, the rights referred to in Article 7 of Regulation EU/679/16, (the text of which is wholly attached or shown below) may be exercised, within the limits and under the conditions laid down in Articles 8, 9 and 10 of the aforementioned legislative decree. Further information regarding the processing and communication of personal data provided directly or otherwise acquired, may be requested from the secretariat of Neutron Sp a., at the company headquarters.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 Reg. EU/2016/679

1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in intelligible form.

2. The data subject has the right to obtain the indication:

- a) the origin of personal data;
- b) the purposes and methods of processing;
- c) the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;
- d) of the identification data concerning the data controller, data processors and the designated representative pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2;
- e) subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who can learn about them as appointed representative in the State, managers or appointees.

3. The data subject has the right to obtain:

- a) updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of data;
- b) the deletion, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including data which does not need to be kept for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed;
- c) the attestation that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also with regard to their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the event that such fulfillment occurs it proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate use of resources with respect to the protected right;
- d) data portability;

4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:

- a) for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data concerning him, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;
- b) to the processing of personal data concerning him for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct sales or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
